Lyric: spurious



spurious (adj.) - false but intended to seem believable or possible The painting, originally believed to be a *spurious* copy, proved to be an authentic van Gogh.

Lyric: abate



abate (v.) - to lessen, to reduce in severity Once the storm had *abated*, it turned into a beautiful day.

Lyric: Lacerations


abase (v.) - to lower, demean, degrade The CEO *abased* himself in front of his colleagues when he was unaware of the crisis at his own power plant.

laceration (n.) - a cut, a rip Beware, broken glass can cause serious *lacerations*. Notes

Lyric: retaliation


retaliation (n.) - revenge, punishment The American Revolution began with the retaliation of the colonies against unfair British rule.

Lyric: retribution

retribution (n.) - vengeance, revenge, payback After last year's embarrassing loss, the team knew they had to win the championship for *retribution* and glory.

umbrage (n.) - anger, offense, resentment Good teachers help their students, rather than take *umbrage*, when they do not understand a lesson.
