Notes Lyric: maxim maxim (n.) - a common saying of advice or virtue A common *maxim* claims that a watched pot never boils. Lyric: dutiful Notes dutiful (adj.) - obedient, compliant The *dutiful* soldiers served their country.



Notes Lyric: Stagnant stagnant (adj.) - still, not flowing Many can become unemployed in a stagnant economy. Lyric: Torpid Notes torpid (adj.) - lazy, lethargic, moving slowly The torpid tortoise inched across the road. Notes Lyric: doppelganger **doppelgänger** (n.) - a ghostly double of a living person The painter depicted a couple meeting their doppelgängers. Lyric: Mimicking Notes


carouse (v.) - to revel, to party Ed had a headache after a night of *carousing*.

lethargic (adj.) - sluggish, weary, apathetic After playing fetch for hours, the dog felt *lethargic*.
